If the devil made ya do it, then the **Lafayette Rhythm Devils** made you do it, get away with it, gargle some whiskey, and enjoy every last second of it. This group of five ultra-talented angels-in-disguise blends traditional Cajun 'house' music with dancehall to create a tight sound, community spirit, and a devilish frenzy. The days when porches and living rooms were the retreat families and neighbors pined for after a long, hard day's work, to come together, play good music, eat good food, and live life how it was supposed to be lived emanates from **Lafayette Rhythm Devils'** traditional spirit. Yet their furious tunes and *envie* of the good life jolts those families & neighbors from their porch swings and transports them smack dab into the dancehalls forcing them to get up off their seats and dance like they mean it.

Here, Louisiana's "Joie de Vivre" takes over, and the **Lafayette Rhythm Devils** are enthusiastic about sharing their heritage with fire and emotion. Kristi Guillory on accordion (also of Bonsoir, Catin) and Randy Vidrine on guitar head the group with energetic vocals, Chris Segura adds fuel to the fire with his improvisational fiddling, Donald LeJeune on drums and Yvette Landry on bass provide the driving beat that IS the **Lafayette Rhythm** of the **Devils**. With three released c.d.s under their belt (*Pray For Us, Runnin'*, and *Les Clefs de la Prison*, and due to release a fourth this fall, these seasoned musicians add the perfect amount of spice to any gig.

The **Lafayette Rhythm Devils** are regulars on Wednesday nights at Randol's, can often be seen exciting the crowd at Fred's Lounge in Mamou, and are ready to kick up some dust at a club or festival near you.
